(a blend of 47% cabernet sauvignon, 47% cabernet franc and 6% merlot): Opaque, deep ruby-red. Spicy aromas of blueberry, violet pastille, licorice, dark chocolate and black pepper. Very concentrated but currently a bit tightly wound. Nicely rich wine with somewhat oak-dominated dark and red fruit flavors on the long finish.

(a 50/50 blend of cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc): Deep ruby-red. Roasted plum, minerals, lead pencil and cocoa powder on the nose and palate. Lush, silky and sweet, showing solid structure but an essentially gentle style for a wine from the Tuscan Coast (the cabernet franc really helps in this respect). Boasts compelling sweetness of fruit and a lovely floral element on the long finish, which features soft, spreading tannins.

(a 50/50 blend of cabernet sauvignon and cabernet franc): Bright pink. Fresh aromas and flavors of wild strawberry, orange rind and almond flower. Finishes juicy, brisk and clean. I'm not usually a fan of cabernet rosés, but this one is pretty darn good.
